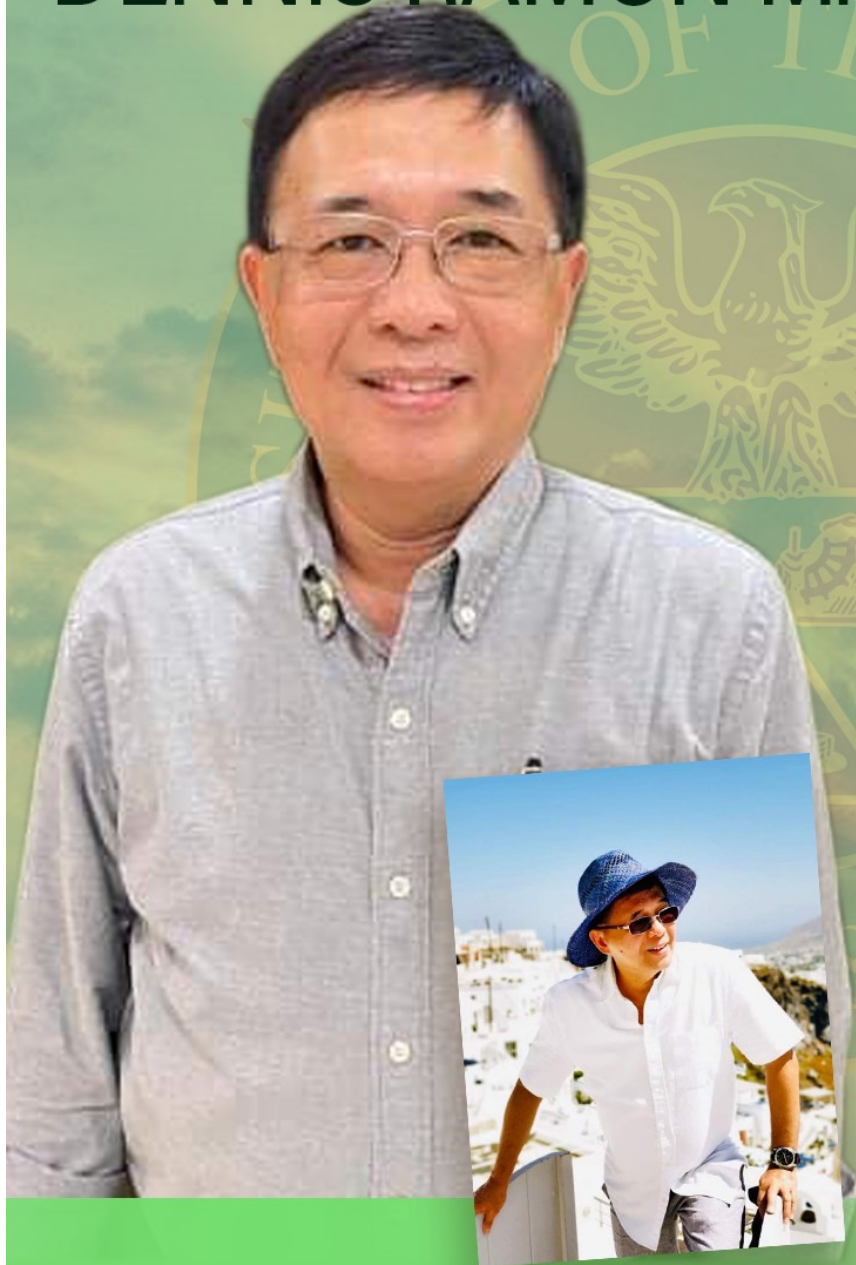


Epitome of a Selfless and Devout Healer
